## Jazz trumpeter featured

Canadian trumpeter Gary Guthman will be the featured guest soloist at Lewis & Clark College's Jazz Night on Saturday, March 9, at 8 p.m. in Evans Auditorium.

Directed by Dave Becker, the Lewis & Clark College Jazz Ensemble will play several contemporary big band arrangements that they recently performed at the Willamette Jazz Festival in Salem. They also will back Guthman as he performs in a variety of jazz styles.

Born in Portland, Guthman graduated from Cleveland High School and Portland State University before moving to Canada in 1974. He has performed with the big bands of Tommy Dorsey, Stan Kenton, Don Ellis and others, and has been a principal player with the Edmonton Symphony, Vancouver Opera and Vancouver CBC Orchestras. He has performed with artists ranging from Tom Jones, Paul Anka, Dionne Warwick and Paul Williams to Conway Twitty and Charlie Pride to the Bee Gees and Gladys Knight.

Guthman's first album, Moonchild, was produced by Pickwick records and released in 1980.

## Don't miss Ghanan film

"Kukurantumi — the Road to Accra," a rare film from Ghana, will be shown Monday, March 11, 7 p.m. at the Northwest Film Study Center Auditorium, 1219 S.W. Park. Admission is \$4.50.

Directed by King Ampaw, "Kukurantumi" portrays the rapid changes that have come to this West African country. Kukurantumi is a small village near Accra, the capital, where men are finding alternatives to agrarian ways and where women are finding totally new social opportunities.

Accra is a bustling sea of galvanized rooftops where the price of a beer is twice the average daily wage. Women there find that economic self-sufficiency sometimes leads them into prostitution. This sensitive portrayal of the social problems resulting from the conflict of old and new speaks not only to Ghana, but to difficulties throughout the Third World. "Kukurantumi" come to Portland as part of the film study center's International Film Festival, March 7 - 24.

## The Good Fight to air

"The Good Fight" is a stirring film about the Abraham Lincoln Brigade, a group of 3,000 American volunteers who fought Fascism in Spain during the 1930s. There will be two showings on Sunday, March 10th. The first will be at 2 p.m. at Vollum Hall, Reed College, 3202 SE Woodstock. Special guests will be Bob Reed, a veteran of the Abraham Lincoln Brigade, and Diane Hess of the Portland-Corinto Sister Cities Project.

The second showing will be at 7 p.m., Room 75, Lincoln Hall, Portland State University, corner of Broadway and Market, with special guests Bob Reed and Bob Lindberg, Portland City Councilman.

A \$3 donation is requested to benefit the Northwest Nicaragua Ambulance Fund and the Oxfam tools for Peace Program. The programs are presented by the Central America Study and Action (PSU), the Reed Peace Community, Reed College Central America Committee, and the Portland Central America Solidarity Committee.
