### INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Manager of the Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon (mailing address: P.O. Box 3629, Portland, OR 97208) for items detailed herein until the individually specified dates and times indicated, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

(Bids must be on the bid form provided to prospective bidders and, when Bid Surety is required, must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank, or a bid bond payable to the Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

When prequalification is required, the requalification statements should be received at least 10 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 10 days before bid opening, but consideration by the Port cannot be assured.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.360, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.

Scope: The work includes grooving portions of Runway 10L-28R and Exit N5 at Portland International Airport. The area to be grooved is asphalt concrete.

Terminal 6 Rubber-tired Gantry Crane Lane Repair (MBE) Incentive Program	April 23, 1985 4:00 p.m.
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Scope: Remove approximately 5,378 lineal feet of 6-inch reinforced concrete gantry crane lanes; excavate 18 inches of lime, cement and poz-zolan soil cement (LCPF) below 5,378 feet of the lanes; construct approximately 5,578 lineal feet of 22-inch-deep reinforced concrete gantry crane lane; partially demolish and fill 3 electrical vaults with concrete; relocate approximately 180 lineal feet of steel plates and move approximately 90 lineal feet of steel plates to storage area on site.

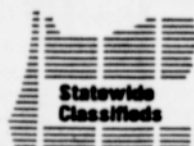
