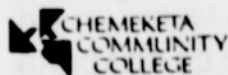

The Volunteer Bureau, a United Way agency, matches prospective volunteers with the needs of approximately 200 local agencies and programs. To find the right volunteer job, call

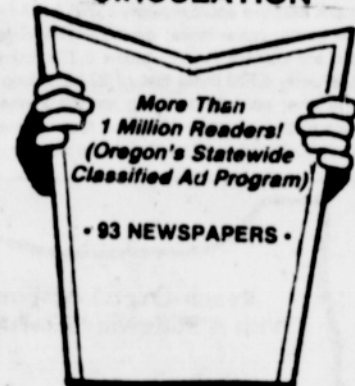
