An Observer Hagler history primer:

April 7, 1978 at Los Angeles — Hagler, still largely unknown, wins his first title, taking the U.S. middle-weight championship with an eighth-round knockout of Doug Demmings.

Feb. 2, 1979 at Boston — Hagler moved into world title contention with a devastating first round knockout of highly regarded Sugar Ray Seales, the former Olympic champion.

Nov. 30, 1979 at Las Vegas — Hagler finally gets his long-awaited title shot and lets it slip away. He dominates the early stages of his fight against defending champion Vito Antuoferno but seems to falter in the later rounds. Though most ringside observers have Hagler ahead, the fight is ruled a draw and Antuoferno retains his title.

April 20, 1980 at Portland, Maine — Marching toward another title shot, Hagler avenges one of his two career losses by knocking out Bobby Watts in just two rounds. Watts had scored a 10-round decision over Hagler in January, 1976. Hagler earlier avenged his other career loss, a 10-round defeat by Willie Monroe, also with a second-round knockout.

Sept. 27, 1980 at London — The title finally belongs to Hagler. He unleashes a blistering two-fisted attack

that turns champion Alan Minter's face into a bloody mask. The fight is stopped in the third round and Hagler and his handlers are pelted with bottles and debris from the hostile British crowd.

June 13, 1981 at Boston — The rematch against Antuoferno and this time Hagler leaves no doubt about the outcome. He opens severe cuts around both of Antuoferno's eyes and the fight is stopped in the fifth round.

Feb. 11, 1983 at Worcester, Mass. — There are many who feel that rugged Tony Sibson of Britain has the style to beat Hagler. Hagler proves them wrong as he opens a deep gash above Sibson's eye and hammers him with a combination of blows until the fight is stopped in the sixth round.

Nov. 10, 1983 at Las Vegas — Hagler survives his toughest test as champion with a 15-round unanimous decision over three-time champion Roberto Duran. Hagler, a heavy favorite, gets caught up in a tactical fight with the wily Duran and is nearly upset. Hagler trails on the officials' cards, though most at ringside feel he is comfortably ahead, at the end of 13 rounds and outpunches Duran over the final two rounds to win.

March 30, 1984 at Las Vegas — Hagler is expected to have an easy time with Juan Domingo Roldan but the brawler from Argentina surprises him. Hagler goes down for the first time in his career in the first round, although the call is highly questionable, and finally puts away the rugged challenger in the 10th round.
