Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Manager of the Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon (mailing address: P.O. Box 3529, Portland, OR 97208) for items detailed herein until the individually specified dates and times indicated, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Bids must be on the bid form provided to prospective bidders and, when Bid Surety is required, must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank, or a bid bond payable to the Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

When prequalification is required, the requalification statements should be received at least 10 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 10 days before bid opening, but consideration by the Port cannot be assured.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.

Sealed bids for the S.E. Fir Villa Road Sanitary Sewer Project will be received at the office of the City manager, City Hall, Dallas, Oregon, until 10:00 A.M., Wednesday, May 1, 1985, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at City Council Chambers, City Hall, Dallas, Oregon.

This is a Federally funded project, and all bidders will be required to comply with all applicable City, County, State and Federal regulations.

The proposed work consists of 2,186 feet of 10" P.V.C. sanitary sewer main, 29 sanitary 4" sewer laterals, and asphalt pavement plugging and patching with 510 tons of asphalt pavement street overlay.

Plans, specifications, and additional information may be obtained from the office of the City Manager or the office of the Director of Public Works, City Hall, Dallas, Oregon.
