

Scope:

Removing and replacing approximately 8,050 square yards of asphaltic concrete pavement and slurry sealing approximately 2,300 square yards; removing and replacing the existing drainage system; regrading the railroad tracks; installing a buikhead anchoring system; installing four new mechanical utility service stations; removing existing underwharf compressed air, natural gas, oxygen, steam, and water branch lines; installing conduit system for future substation; removing existing area lighting and installing new poles with a combination of both new and existing luminaires; and providing new temporary power supply to new lighting.
