Sealed bids will be received by the Purchasing Manager of the Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon (mailing address: P.O. Box 3529, Portland, OR 97208) for items detailed herein until the individually specified dates and times indicated, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Bids must be on the bid form provided to prospective bidders and, when Bid Surety is required, must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank, or a bid bond payable to the Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

When prequalification is required, the prequalification statements should be received at least 10 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 10 days before bid opening, but consideration by the Port cannot be assured.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.

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Scope: Design and construct a one-story factory-built modular office structure complete with a pressure-treated all-weather wood foundation on a site to be designated at the Port of Portland. The work also includes a 1-inch water supply, an underground conduit to electric meter base, a pad-mounted transformer, a 6-inch sanitary sewer, a 4-inch perforated perimeter storm water line connected to downspouts, concrete pads, and entry/exit stairs and ramp.
