"Since the year 1957 when I was converted to Jesus Christ, I have traveled far and wide telling people that Jesus, the son of the living God is the same yesterday, today and forever. My calling is to 'win souls'! I have seen them come to the master by the thousands, miracles of healing have been performed upon the sick, demons flee as I proclaim Christ. Many times the Lord has revealed Himself to people in different forms! In Ethiopia they do not only starve for food but for the word of God, said Evangelist Kayo. Your missionaries coming from the U.S. are outdated, there are powers of darkness in Africa that only the power of the Holy Ghost can break. There are many pastors and leaders in Africa with no Bibles. In certain countries and parts of Africa they will not allow the people to have Bibles," he said.
