Sealed bids will be received until 2:30 p.m. on June 18, 1985 at the office of the Beaverton City Purchasing Supervisor, 4950 SW Hall Blvd., Beaverton, Oregon 97006 and publicly read aloud immediately thereafter in the City Courtroom for all materials and labor relating to the Tenant Space Completion Project.

The proposed work consists of completion of an unfinished tenant space at the recently completed City Library. Total area is approximately 2,100 square feet. Work includes installation of a roof mounted heat pump and duct work. Electrical to include light fixtures, suspended ceiling grid, gypsum drywall, painting and floor covering.

Each proposal must be submitted on forms prescribed by the City and accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond in an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total amount bid. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a bond equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of bid for the faithful performance of the contract.

No bid will be received or considered unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder as a part of his bid that the provisions of ORS 279.350 and ORS 279.354 will be complied with.
