

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, Room B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until July 23, 1985, at 2:30 PM, PDT, for the Oceanography II - Room 382 Remodel project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A", Room A110 by the Undersigned or his designated representative.

The project consists of furnishing all labor, material, equipment, superintendence and doing all work to remodel room 382, all in strict accordance with the plans and specifications.

A pre-bid walk through will be held on Monday, July 13, 1985 at 2:30 PM. Participants will meet at the Physical Plant office.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. One set of plans, specifications and forms of contract documents may be obtained from the Physical Plant, Oregon State University, 606 S.W. 15th Street, Corvallis, Oregon 97331 (phone number 754-4921) by prime bidders only upon deposit of \$25.00. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction. Subcontractors and others may purchase a set of plans and specifications for \$5.00.

Deposits will be refunded for documents returned in "good condition" by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, or by non-bidders by the bid opening date.

Drawings, specifications and forms of contract documents may be examined at the Oregon State University Physical Plant, as well as at the following locations: Builders Exchange Cooperative, Portland, Oregon; Eugene Builders Exchange Corporation, Eugene, Oregon; Northwest Plan Center, Portland, Oregon; Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem, Oregon; Construction Data Plan Center, Portland, Oregon; Impact Business Consultants, Portland, Oregon; and National Business League—Oregon Chapter, c/o CSS & Associates, Portland, Oregon.

Prequalifications of bidders is not required for this project.

All bids must contain a statement assuring compliance with ORS 279.350 relating to prevailing rates of wage.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.

The Oregon State Board of Higher Education reserves the right to reject all bids and to waive all informalities.

No bidder may withdraw a bid after the hour set for the opening thereof until after the lapse of thirty (30) days from the bid opening.

Sealed bids for the Portland International Airport, Concourse K, Gates 49A and 49B, Interior Partitions and Exit Stairs will be received by the Purchasing Manager of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon, (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until 2:00 p.m., July 9, 1985, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (MBE) INCENTIVE PROGRAM:
A 2 PERCENT BIDDING ADVANTAGE WILL BE GIVEN TO BIDDERS WHO:

1. HAVE BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE PORT OF PORTLAND AS MBEs, OR
2. EMPLOY SUBCONTRACTORS THAT HAVE BEEN CERTIFIED BY THE PORT OF PORTLAND AS MBEs AND ARRANGE FOR THEM TO PERFORM WORK THAT REPRESENTS NOT LESS THAN 10 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL DOLLAR AMOUNT BID.

Construction of exit stairs and modification of the terminal building (Concourse K) by the addition of partitioning walls.

A prebid conference will be held Thursday, July 27, 1985, at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room 3006 on the third floor mezzanine in the terminal building at Portland International Airport to discuss all phases of the work.

Bids must be on the bid form which will be provided to prospective bidders and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to The Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

Bidders are required to prequalify. Prequalification statements must be received at least 5 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 5 days before bid opening, but consideration by Port cannot be assured.

The drawings and the contract manual may be examined at Port offices. Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders upon deposit of \$10, which deposit will be refunded upon return of the drawings, contract manual, and other documents in good condition within 2 weeks after bid opening.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.
