

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

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CITY OF ST. HELENS, OREGON
N. VERNONIA ROAD SEWER PROJECT

Sealed Bids for the construction of SANITARY SEWERS, AND MANHOLES in the City of St. Helens, Oregon addressed to the Mayor and City Council, City Hall, 265 Strand Street, P.O. Box 278, St. Helens, Oregon 97061, will be received until 2:30 p.m. local time on the 25th day of July 1986, in the City Recorder's Office in City Hall, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of constructing approximately 4,030 lineal feet of 8 & 10" diameter gravity flow sewer; approximately 675 lineal feet of 4" service lateral; and 12 manholes.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the St. Helens City Hall; at the Northwest Plan Center, 901 SE Oak, Portland, OR; at Builders Exchange, 1125 SE Madison, Portland, OR; at Impact Business Consultants, Business Development Center, 8959 SW Barber Blvd., Suite 102, Portland, OR; and at the offices of the Engineers, Whiteley, Jacobson & Associates, 8525 N. Lombard, Portland, OR 9703, ph. 286-8803.

Copies of the Contract Documents and Drawings may be obtained from the City of St. Helens upon payment of \$60 for each set.

Bidders upon returning the Documents, in good condition, within 10 days of the bid opening will be refunded their payment.

Bidders in doubt as to their qualifications to perform the work are encouraged to contact the Engineer informally to determine if a prequalification request is necessary. Prequalification requests must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 15th day of July, 1986.

Each Bid must contain a statement by the Bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.360 shall be complied with.

Prospective Bidders are advised that the work is partially funded by a grant from the State of Oregon Intergovernmental Relations Division and that the work will be subject to the prevailing wage rates established by the U.S. Department of Labor and to Equal Employment Opportunity requirements.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of St. Helens, Oregon in an amount of not less than 10 percent of the total amount of the Bid.

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds in the full amount of the contract price. A City business license is also required for doing business in the City.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in bidding. No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 60 calendar days after the opening thereof.

FOR THE SIDEWALK RESTORATION AT
NORDSTROM MALL

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 206, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on July 31, 1986 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "SIDEWALK RESTORATION AT NORDSTROM MALL."

The proposed work consists of: the restoration of the tile paver sidewalk surface at Nordstrom Mall by removing and replacing approximately 225 square feet of existing tile and pouring exposed aggregate pedestrian ramps, and miscellaneous appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 206, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked BID ON NORDSTROM MALL SIDEWALK PROJECT," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.360 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before July 23, 1986 which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.
