## INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 206, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, until but not after 11:00 a.m., July 31, 1985, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

The specifications and other bid documents are available at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th Street SE, Salem, Oregon 97302. The proposed work consists of THE CONSTRUCTION OF CHAIN LINK FENCING AT WALLACE MARINE PARK.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to prequalified bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON WALLACE MARINE PARK CHAIN LINK FENCE" and show the name and business address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of 10 percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidders will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been awarded.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of the ORS 279.360 shall be included in his contract.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities, and of postponing the award of the contract for 30 days.

Contractor's Prequalification Application must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street SE, Salem, Oregon 97302) for approval, on or before July 24, 1985, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval, the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

## INVITATION FOR BIDS

PROJECT NO. C 4-8801

Sealed bids for window modifications will be received by The Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) at 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97203, until 2:00 p.m., PDT, Wednesday, August 7, 1985, and following a short interval, bids will be opened and read aloud. Bidders are welcome to attend the bid opening.

Basically the work consists of removing eighty-three (83) existing single glazed wood sash and replacing with double glazed medal windows and weatherstrip eighty-three (83) existing wood sash that are to remain. Extend and upgrade existing fire sprinkler system.

A prebid inspection of the site and conditions thereof will be held at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, July 25, 1985. The jobsite is located at 1218 S.W. Washington St., Portland, Oregon. A HAP representative will conduct a tour of the building at the time indicated and will discuss questions posed that are relative to the work. Answers to questions that are not defined in the Specifications will be forwarded to all bidders by addenda. Contractors and parties interested in bidding this project should attend this tour.

Prospective bidders may obtain one set of bidding documents at the HAP office, 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. upon deposit of \$20 which will be refunded upon return of undamaged documents within ten (10) days after the bid opening. Additional sets of plans or specifications may be obtained at \$10 each which is not refundable.

A minimum of 20% MBE participation in the execution of this project is a HAP requirement and the methods of the bidder proposes in complying with this requirement is subject to HAP review and approval prior to initiating the contract.

No bid will be considered unless accompanied by Bid Security in the form of certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond payable to the Housing Authority of Portland in the amount equal to 10% of the bid to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract or provide suitable bond for the faithful performance of the work in the event contract is awarded to the bidder.

No bidder may withdraw from a bid after the hour set for the opening thereof until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.

The Housing Authority of Portland may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed bidding procedures and requirements and may reject any or all bids, and waive all informalities if in the judgment of HAP, it is in the public interest to do so.
