REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

To Vendors of Computer Software and/or computer Systems (Hardware and Software) specifically designed for Housing Authorities and their housing management.

The Housing Authority of Lincoln County is currently making requests for proposals for an automated in-house management system for the management of four projects: Low-Rent Public Housing (85 units); Section 8 Existing Housing (280 units); and two separate Section 8 projects (50 units and 12 units) to maintain files, generate and repeatedly generate numerous forms, reports, and mailings, maintain accounts on each project, administrative accounting, housing maintenance, and inventory management.

The Housing Authority of Lincoln County is currently seeking procurement of automated data processing equipment through the process of competitive negotiation.
