No bid will be considered unless accompanied by Bid Security in the form of certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond payable to the Housing Authority of Portland in an amount equal to 10% of the bid to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract or provide suitable bond for the faithful performance of the work in the event the contract is awarded.
