## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon, until 2:00 p.m., PDT, August 27, 1985, for the Parking Improvements project located on the campus of Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A", Room A110 by the Undersigned or designated representative.

The project consists of excavating, grading, filling, installing storm sewer systems, asphaltic concrete surfacing, Portland cement surfacing, curbs, driveways and all other items for completing the Parking Lot Improvements.

Separate bids will be received for three groups of parking lots. One set of plans, specifications and forms of contract documents may be obtained from the OSU Physical Plant, 606 S.W. 15th Street, Corvallis, Oregon 97331 (phone number 754-4921) by prime bidders only upon deposit of \$25.00. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction. Subcontractors and others may purchase a set of plans and specifications for \$5.00.

Deposits will be refunded for documents returned in "good condition" by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, or by non-bidders by the bid opening date.

Bidders for this general work are required to be prequalified in accordance with OAR 580-50-030. Applications for prequalification (or notice of intent to bid if the Contractor has a current prequalification application on file with the Undersigned) must be received at least ten (10) days prior to the bid opening.

All bidders must comply with the requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279.350.

A pre-bid walk through will be held on August 20, 1985 at 1:30 PM. Bidders shall meet at the Physical Plant Office.

## INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bid proposals for construction of street improvements in Molalla, Oregon, will be received by the Clackamas County Community Development Division on August 27, 1985 at 2:00 p.m. at O'Hara Hall, Marylhurst College, Marylhurst, Oregon. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. No bids will be received or considered after that time.

Proposed work will consist of the paving of two streets with the combined length of approximately 3,050 lineal feet.
