The proposed work consists of: Excavating, dismantling and relaying 380 lineal feet of concrete cylinder force main pipe and other appurtenant work.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening: all bid security will be refunded ultipon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before September 17, 1985 which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

Sealed bids for health and safety construction at three (3) nondwelling buildings will be received by the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) at 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97203 until 2:00 p.m., PDT, Tuesday, October 8, 1985. Following a short interval, the bids will be opened and read aloud. Bidders may attend the bid opening.

Briefly, the work consists of, but is not limited to Mechanical/Electrical/ Plumbing construction which includes the installation of three dust/smoke collecting systems, construction of paint spray booth, two fire sprinkler systems and rough carpentry.

A HAP representative will conduct a tour of the job sites commencing at 10:00 a.m. Thursday, September 19, 1985, at 8910 N. Woolsey Ave. and all bidders are requested to attend. Questions regarding the project will be answered by addenda and provided to all bidders.

A minimum of 20% participation in the execution of this project is a HAP requirement and the methods the bidder proposes in complying with this requirement is subject to HAP review and approval prior to initiating the contract.

No bid will be considered unless accompanied by Bid Security in the form of certified check, cashier's check, or security bond payable to the Housing Authority of Portland in an amount equal to 10% of the bid to be forferted as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract or provide a suitable bond for the faithful performance of the work in the event the contract is awarded.

No bidder may withdraw after the hour set for the opening thereof until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.

The Housing Authority of Portland may reject any bid not in compliance with all prescribed bidding procedures and requirements and may reject any or all bids, and waive all formalities if in the judgment of HAP it is in the public interest to do so.
