### EWING SIGNS WITH KNICKS

Patrick Ewing, former three-time All-American center from George town University, became the highest paid rookie in National Basketball history. The seven-foot Ewing, first player picked by the New York Knicks in the June draft, was said to have signed a five to seven year deal worth between \$12 and \$16 million.

The Knicks are expecting big things from Ewing, such as leading the Knicks to the NBA Eastern Conference Championship and a NBA championship. Ewing has already contributed to the Knicks before he even played a game: since New York drafted Ewing, 5,000 new season tickets have been sold.

### SPINKS UPSETS HOLMES

Michael Spinks made boxing history last Saturday in Las Vegas when he became the first light-heavyweight champion to win the world heavyweight title.

Spinks, 29, won a unanimous 15-round decision from Larry Holmes. Holmes was trying to tie the record of Rocky Marciano of 49 boxing victories without a loss.

After the defeat, Holmes announced that he was retiring from boxing with a record of 48 wins and one loss. The loss came on the 30th anniversary of Marciano's final fight.

Holmes earned an estimated \$3.5 million for his final fight and Spinks earned \$1 million.

### GRAMBLING COACH ONE VICTORY AWAY FROM RECORD

Grambling University coach, Eddie Robinson, could tie the record held by the late Paul "Bear" Bryant Saturday when Grambling hosts Oregon State.

Robinson won victory number 322 last week as his Grambling Tigers blasted North Carolina Central 45-14 in the annual Whitney M. Young Jr. Football Classic at Yankee Stadium.

If Grambling beats Oregon State, Robinson would tie Bryant's record of 323 career wins.

### Second Run for Liberty Oct. 12

Olympic medalist Bruce Jenner invited Portland residents of every size, age and shape to participate in the restoration of the Statue of Liberty by running in the Oct. 12 Stroh's Run for Liberty.

"The Stroh's Run for Liberty is the world's largest single day run and involves Americans in every state," Jenner said. "You don't have to be the world's greatest athlete, though, to participate. Walkers, joggers and serious runners are encouraged to sign up."

Jenner, the 1976 Olympic decathlon winner earning the title of the World's Greatest Athlete, was recently appointed official spokesperson for the eight kilometer or five mile run to be held in 127 cities and seven military installations across the United States.

"As Americans living in the spirit of freedom and democracy we should take this opportunity to give ourselves to the Statue of Liberty. For each of us that participates, the Stroh

Brewery Company will donate a minimum \$2 entry fee to the restoration fund," Jenner said.

The Run for Liberty is sponsored by Stroh and supported by the Plymouth division of Chrysler Corporation. Adidas USA is the official athletic footwear and apparel for the event. Stroh established the run in 1984 following a \$3 million pledge to the restoration project.

In its inaugural year the run gained more than 140,000 participants in 123 cities.

To register for the Oct. 12 run, pick up entry forms that are available at participating Chrysler Plymouth dealers and where Stroh's beer is sold. The entry fee is \$8 until Oct. 1 and \$11 through Oct. 12.


All runners will receive a medallion cast from metal of the original Statue of Liberty made almost a century ago and a commemorative booklet containing individual race and time results in every market.


