Portland Opera General Director Robert Bailey announced today that New York soprano Faye Robinson is making her second appearance with the company starting in the opening production of Portland Opera Association's 21st anniversary season, *The Tales of Hoffman* by Jacques Offenbach. The hauntingly beautiful fantasy will be performed in French with a simultaneous English Supertext translation projected on a screen above the stage on September 28 and October 2 and 5 at 8 p.m. at the Civic Auditorium.

Faye Robinson comes to Portland fresh from her triumphant return to the New York City Opera in Bellini's *I Puritani*. She has also sung leading roles with the opera companies of Vienna, Paris, Hamburg, Cologne, Munich, New Orleans, Pittsburgh, Philadelphia, San Diego, and also Teatro Colon in Buenos Aires and the Florentine Opera of Milwaukee. Much in demand as a concert artist, she has sung with virtually every major orchestra, including the New York Philharmonic, Philadelphia Orchestra, the Symphony Orchestra of Chicago and Boston, the Los Angeles Philharmonic, the Atlanta Symphony, the Cleveland Orchestra and the Concertgebouw in Amsterdam.

Good seats are still available for *The Tales of Hoffmann*, especially for the September 28 and October 2 performances. Ticket prices start at \$15 for second balcony seats. The Opera gives discounts of 10 percent on orders of 20 tickets or more. Students, senior citizens, faculty and military personnel with valid I.D.s may obtain "rush" tickets for \$6.00 at 7:30 before each performance. Guest artists offer "Opera Insights," popular pre-curtain lectures at 7:00 p.m. each performance evening. Tickets are available through Steven & Son Lloyd Center, the Civic Auditorium and the Portland Opera office, 241-1401.
