## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, Room B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until 2:00 PM, PST, Tuesday, November 5, 1985 for the Snell Hall Third Floor Remodel project located at Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A", Room A110 by the Undersigned or a designated representative.

The project includes demolition, carpentry, doors, suspended ceilings, painting and associated mechanical and electrical work.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained from the office of Jeppsen, Miller and Tobias, Architects, 245 NE Conifer Blvd., Corvallis, Oregon 97330 (754-7541) by prime bidders only upon deposit of \$25. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction. Subcontractors and others may purchase a set of plans and specifications for \$15.

Contract documents may be examined at the Architect's office; Builders Exchange Cooperative, Portland; Eugene Builders Exchange Corporation, Eugene; Northwest Plan Center, Portland; Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem; Construction Data Plan Center, Portland; Impact Business Consultants, Portland; National Business League-Oregon Chapter, c/o CSS & Associates, Portland; and Central Oregon Builders Exchange, Bend.

Deposits will be refunded for contract documents returned in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, but to non-bidders only if returned no later than the day of the bid opening.

Bidders are required to be prequalified in accordance with OAR 580-50-030. Applications for prequalification (or notice of intent to bid if the contractor has a current prequalification application on file with the Undersigned) must be received at least ten (10) days prior to the bid opening.

All bidders must comply with the requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279.350.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.

FOR THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION IN  
HIGH STREET SOUTHEAST, LINCOLN STREET TO  
McGILCHRIST STREET

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 206, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., local time on October 23, 1985 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 566 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION IN HIGH STREET SOUTHEAST, LINCOLN STREET TO McGILCHRIST STREET."

The proposed work consists of: construction of 1,582 lineal feet of 8-inch and 966 lineal feet of 10-inch sewer pipe, seven (7) manholes, 67 service reconstructions, and miscellaneous appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 566 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 206, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON HIGH STREET SOUTHEAST, LINCOLN STREET TO McGILCHRIST STREET," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before October 15, 1985 which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.
