FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF BIKEWAY AND LEFT TURN LANE ON SOUTH RIVER ROAD, MINTO PARK ROAD TO SCHURMAN DRIVE

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on December 4, 1985 at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon, for the "CONSTRUCTION OF BIKEWAY AND LEFT TURN LANE ON SOUTH RIVER ROAD, MINTO PARK ROAD TO SCHURMAN DRIVE".

The proposed work consists of: constructing left turn lanes and bike lanes on both sides of 700 feet of City street, together with storm drainage and all appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON BIKEWAY AND LEFT TURN ON SOUTH RIVER ROAD," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before November 26, 1985, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.
