**1985 Ecumenical Humanitarian Awards announced**

Bishop Rustin Kimsey, President of Ecumenical Ministries of Oregon, announced this week the recipients of the Ecumenical Humanitarian Award and the 1985 Ecumenical Service Awards.

The 1985 Ecumenical Humanitarian Award will go jointly to Howard and Jean Vollum, who, while having an abiding commitment to the values of the Judeo-Christian faith, have, through creative philanthropic giving, enhanced and enriched our state beyond measure.

The 1985 Ecumenical Service Awards will go to Congressman Les AuCoin, for the innovative and talented leadership he provided in the recent "Lights On For Peace" campaign that gained world-wide participation during the summit meeting between President Reagan and Michael Gorbachev; Portland Chief of Police Penny Harrington, for her blueprint for a new partnership between the police and the citizens of Portland and for her building new bridges of understanding; to Bishop Thomas Connolly and The Reverend Tom Castlen, for work in helping the poor of Oregon by assisting in passing the Two Parent Public Assistance bill. Bishop Connolly is the bishop for the Roman Catholic Diocese of Baker (Eastern Oregon) and The Reverend Castlen is the Synod Executive for the Presbyterian Church U.S.A. in Western Oregon.

The awards will be made at the 69th Annual Meeting of Ecumenical Ministries on Jan. 26 at Westminster Presbyterian Church, 1624 N.E. Hancock. A reception will be held for the honorees at 5:30 p.m. followed by a dinner and awards presentation at 6:00 p.m.

Keynote speaker for the dinner will be Dr. Arie Brouwer, new General Secretary of the National Council of Churches of Christ. He will speak on the theme "Together We Make a

World of Difference."

Bishop Kimsey stated, "It will be with great joy as some of the people of God gather to honor those among us that have helped make our community, state, nation and world a better place for everyone."

**Australian feminist to speak**

Radical Women organizer Alison Thorne of Melbourne, Australia, will discuss the history of women's fight to win and retain reproductive rights in her country at the January Portland Radical Women meeting.

Thorne is a member of the Australian Labor Party and the Technical Teachers Union. She is well known in Australia for her on-going free speech case against the Department of Education. A popular teacher, Thorne was reassigned to administrative duties after she publicly defended gay rights. Her fight to win reinstatement to her teaching post has garnered international support and attention from unionists, feminists, gay rights advocates and civil libertarians.

Thorne will speak at the Multnomah County Central Library, 801 S.W. 10th Ave., on Thursday, Jan. 16, at 6:30 p.m. The library is wheelchair accessible.

Radical Women will also host a reception for Thorne on Friday, Jan. 17, beginning at 7:00 p.m., at the home of Diana Lobo, 2824 N.E. Skidmore. The public is invited to attend.
