The Living King: Ebony honors the Drum Major for Justice

In honor of the first national holiday commemorating the birth of the slain civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Ebony presents a special section, "The Living King," in the January issue.

This moving special section-in photos, reprints, and essays-brings to life both the joy and the tears of Dr. king's leadership of the non-violence movement. Included are: a reprint of Dr. King's most famous speech, "I Have a Dream"; the King Holiday Legislation with remarks by President Reagan and Mrs. King; "Important Dates in the Life of Martin Luther King, Jr.," a year-by-year chronicle from birth to assassination; "Martin's Legacy," by

Coretta Scott King; "The Young Martin," childhood remembrances by his sister, Christine King Farris; and "Memorable Photos from the King Years."

In addition, 10 well-known people including the Rev. Jesse Jackson, Senator Edward Kennedy, and Atlanta Mayor Andrew Young tell how Dr. King influences their lives today; King artwork and commemorative stamps from around the world are featured; books authored by Dr. King are spotlighted; and historian Lerone Bennett, Jr. explains "The Real Meaning of the King Holiday.'


