

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

PORT OF PORTLAND MINORITY BUSINESS ENTERPRISE PROGRAM POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the Port of Portland Commission, through a commitment to the minority and female business enterprise community, to establish goals whereby minority- and women-owned businesses have the opportunity to participate in Portwide and airport construction contracts and professional services and are given the opportunity to bid on airport concession leases and service contracts; and

The objective of the fiscal year 1986 Minority Business Enterprise Program is to stimulate minority business enterprise participation in the Port's competitive bidding process and in airport concession leases and service contracts; and

That such a program consist of:

1. A goal of 10 percent participation by minority business enterprises and 3 percent participation by women-owned enterprises in Portwide construction projects.
2. A goal of 10 percent participation by minority business enterprises and 2 percent participation by women-owned business enterprises in federally funded airport construction.
3. Special efforts are made to solicit the interest of minority and women consulting firms in the selection process for consulting services.
4. Minority- and women-owned firms shall have maximum opportunity to participate in the concession and consumer service agreements at Portland International Airport. A goal of 0.84 percent is established for minority- or women-owned entrepreneurs in airport concession and consumer service agreements.
5. Distribution of contents of the program throughout the Port offices and to minority and nonminority communities' business organizations and publications.
6. Designation by the Executive Director of a liaison officer with full responsibility to organize the program and coordinate efforts with the contract, construction, and leasing officers to ensure the success of the program through

accomplishment of the above-stated goals.

The Port will evaluate and adjust the substance of the program annually.

NONDISCRIMINATION

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the provisions of Federal Executive Order 11246. The requirements for Bidders and Contractors are explained in the Specifications.

No bid will be received or considered unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder as part of his bid that the requirements of 279.350, 279.352, 279.355 and 279.356 shall be met.

No proposal will be considered unless accompanied by a check payable to Multnomah County, certified by a responsible bank, or in lieu thereof, a surety bond for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the aggregate proposal. The successful bidder shall furnish a bond satisfactory to the Board in the full amount of the contract.

Multnomah County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
