INVITATION TO BID

REPLACEMENT OF A WATER MAIN IN CAMELLIA DRIVE SOUTH, ACACIA DRIVE SOUTH TO MADRONA AVENUE SOUTH

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on February 19, 1986, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon, for the "REPLACEMENT OF A WATER MAIN IN CAMELLIA DRIVE SOUTH, ACACIA DRIVE SOUTH TO MADRONA AVENUE SOUTH".

The proposed work consists of: installation of 1,670 lineal feet of 12-inch ductile iron pipe, one fire hydrant, and short and long services, together with valves and all appurtenances thereto.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON CAMELLIA DRIVE WATER MAIN," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before February 11, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, until, but not after 11:00 a.m., February 26, 1986, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

Prime contractors interested in bidding on this project may receive one copy of the specifications and other bid documents at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302. The proposed work consists of the removal of all existing sludge from Lagoons No. 2 and 4 at the Willow Lake Wastewater Treatment Plant and hauling the sludge to the Brown's Island Landfill.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON 1986 SLUDGE LAGOON CLEANING PROJECT", and show the name and business address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidders will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been awarded.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities and of postponing the award of the contract for thirty (30) days.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

NOTE: A MANDATORY site orientation will be held at the Willow Lake Sewage Treatment Plant, 5915 Windsor Island Rd. North, Administration Building, Salem, Oregon 97303, at 10:00 a.m., February 18, 1986. All prospective bidders MUST attend.
