INVITATION TO BID

FOR THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION IN SKOPIL AVENUE SOUTH, CANDALARIA BOULEVARD TO BOICE STREET

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., local time on March 5, 1986, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for "THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION IN SKOPIL AVENUE SOUTH, CANDALARIA BOULEVARD TO BOICE STREET."

The proposed work consists of: construction of 470 lineal feet of 8-inch, 172 lineal feet of 6-inch sewer pipe, three (3) manholes, and miscellaneous appurtenance work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON SKOPIL AVENUE SEWER PROJECT," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before February 25, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

Sealed bids for the Professional School Building, Phase II Portland State University, will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education at Room 202 of the Portland State University Services Building, 617 S.W. Montgomery Street, Portland, Oregon until 8:00 p.m., PST, March 13, 1986 and then publicly opened and read aloud by the undersigned or his designated representative.

Briefly the work is described as the construction of a concrete frame office and classroom building, approximately 53,000 square feet of space on six levels, and separate phasing for demolition of Francis Manor and construction of bridge.

Bids will be received for the total work only. Two sets of drawings, specifications and forms of Contract Documents may be obtained by General Contractor from the office of Yost Grube Hall, P.C. Architects, at 1211 S.W. Fifth Ave., Suite 2700, Portland, Oregon 97204-3782, upon deposit of \$300.00 for General Contractor. Additional sets of documents may be purchased at cost, nonrefundable.

Deposits made upon procurement of drawings, specifications and forms of Contract Documents will be refunded upon return thereof in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, but to nonbidders only if returned no later than one week prior to bid opening.

All bids must comply with the requirements of prevailing law in ORS 279.350.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided by the Architects and accompanied by bid security.
