Andrew Young, Arthur Laffer Will Debate at Pacific University

Pacific University, Forest Grove — The liberal mayor of Atlanta, Andrew Young, and a conservative expert on supply side economics, Arthur Laffer of California, will be the 1986 Tom McCall Politics and Law Forum debaters at Pacific University.

The two will debate at 8 p.m. March 6 in the Pacific Athletic Center. The topic will be "Reagan's Stewardship of the Economy."

In the Carter Administration, Young was the United States ambassador to the United Nations. Laffer is considered to be an insider in the Reagan Administration and wrote what is called the Laffer Curve for the supply side theory.

Panelists for the Debate have been named to include a banker and two journalists.

They are Robert Ames, president,

First Interstate Bank of Oregon; William A. Hilliard, executive editor of the Oregonian, and Mindy Cameron, city editor of the Seattle Times. Both Hilliard and Cameron are Pacific alumni.

This panel will ask questions of the debaters after they have made their basic presentations.

Tickets for the debate are \$6 adults and \$3 students. Advance tickets are available at all Meier & Frank ticket outlets, including all stores in the Portland area and in Salem, Eugene, and Vancouver, Wash. They are also being sold at the Student Services Office at Pacific.

The debate name honors the memory of Oregon's 30th governor, Tom McCall.

Pacific is 25 miles west of Portland on Tri-Met Line 57.

Program Set for Summer

Washington, D.C. — Minority college freshmen and sophomores can spend an interesting summer working at their hometown newspapers under the American Society of Newspaper Editors' Project Focus program.

Focus students will be employed in jobs such as clerks, messengers, library assistances or other similar newsroom positions. And they'll get a chance to see firsthand how a daily newspaper is produced. Successful applicants can expect to receive the minimum wage or better.

To qualify, students must be freshmen or sophomores and a racial minority — Asian American, Black, Hispanic, or Native American (American Indian). A 2.5 grade point average or better is required, and applicants must be able to type at least 40 words per minute.

ASNE will screen applications before they will be forwarded to newspapers for employment consideration.


Eligible students can write ASNE for a Project Focus application form or write a letter of application that includes: the student's permanent mailing address and phone; college mailing address and phone; his/her year in school (freshman or sophomore); grade point average; faculty adviser's name, address and phone; and an 800-word typewritten autobiography.

For applications, students should write, ASNE Project Focus, P.O. Box 17004, Washington, DC 20041. Applications will be considered until April 1.
