Separate sealed Bids for the 1986 Sewerage Project - Sewage Treatment Plant Improvements will be received by the City of Nyssa, Malheur County, Oregon at the City Hall located at 14 South Third, Nyssa, Oregon, until 4:00 p.m., prevailing local time, March 17, 1986, and then publicly opened and read aloud.

The Project consists generally of modifications to the existing Sewage Treatment Plant including installation of a head-works grinder, rehabilitation of the existing anaerobic digester, sludge pump installation and piping improvements, construction of heat exchanger building, installation of heat exchanger, installation of aerobic digester pump, construction of sludge drying beds, yard piping, site grading, electrical work, installation of lift station controls and telemetry, purchase of emergency generator and all other related work.

CITY OF GATES INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids for construction of a Municipal Water Treatment Plant will be received on behalf of the City of Gates by Westech Engineering, Inc., 3421 25th Street SE, Salem, Oregon 97302, until 2:00 p.m. local time on the 13th of March, 1986. Proposals shall be clearly marked "Bid for a Municipal Water Treatment Plant" showing date and time of bid opening, and shall be delivered to Westech Engineering, Inc., on or before the above bid opening time.

The work to include the following construction:

A metal building to house a 250 gpm pressure filter treatment facility, installation of owner furnished treatment equipment, including feeders and chlorination equipment, backwash pond, electrical, sitework and miscellaneous appurtenant work.

Bidders must be prequalified with the owner as required by ORS Chapter 279. Only bids from prequalified bidders for this project shall be opened.

Bidders must also comply with the minimum rates for wages as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with provision of the Davis-Bacon Act.

All proposals shall be accompanied by a bid bond equal to ten percent (10%) of the total bid, to be forfeited to the Owner in the event of failure of the Contractor to execute the contract. One hundred percent (100%) performance and payment bonds will be required to guarantee the faithful performance of the contract.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to postpone the award for 30 days, to delete certain items from the proposal, and to award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder.
