INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, until, but not after 11:00 a.m., April 2, 1986, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

Prime contractors interested in bidding on this project may receive one copy of the specifications and other bid documents at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302. The proposed work consists of painting the exterior of the Chemeketa Parking Structure, Salem, Oregon.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to prequalified bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON PAINTING OF THE CHEMEKETA PARKING STRUCTURE", and show the name and business address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidders will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been awarded.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities and of postponing the award of the contract for thirty (30) days.

No bid will be received from any bidder who has not filed a prequalification statement with the City Purchasing Supervisor. Statements must be received by 5:00 p.m. on or before March 25, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.
PREQUALIFICATION CLASS: PAINTING.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

NOTE: A MANDATORY site orientation will be held at the Chemeketa Parking Structure, Chemeketa at Commercial St. N.E. in front of the east elevator tower, Salem, Oregon 97303, at 10:00 a.m., March 25, 1986. Only one orientation will be held. All prospective bidders MUST attend. Attendance at the entire orientation, which is expected to last approximately one hour is required.

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed bids for the construction of a Water Treatment Plan for the City of Vernonia, Columbia County, Oregon will be received by the City until 7:00 p.m. P.S.T., April 1, 1986. Bids submitted prior to the opening will be received by the City Recorder, City Hall, 919 Bridge Street, Vernonia, Oregon.

Bid opening will be conducted in the Council Chambers of the Vernonia City Hall, and publicly opened and read aloud.

The project includes a basic bid for the construction of a 1.0 mg water treatment plant with package treatment units, masonry structure and appurtenant mechanical and electrical construction, an intake structure and Rock Creek channel stabilization improvements. An alternate for construction of a 1.5 mg water treatment plant is included.

Contract documents may be obtained by pre-qualified prospective bidders upon receipt of cash or check made payable to the Engineer in the amount of \$50.00 for each set. Deposits made upon procurement of drawings, specifications, and forms within the Contract Documents will be refundable upon their return in good condition after the opening of bids.

Bidders must pre-qualify with the Owner through the Engineer, on Standard Oregon Review Board Pre-qualification Forms, ten days prior to the bid opening. If a pre-qualification form is on file with the Engineer and is not over one year old, re-filing is not necessary unless there has been a substantial change in Contractor's status.

Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Bond executed in favor of the City of Vernonia in an amount of ten percent of the total amount of the bid.

Any bid awarded pursuant to this Notice to Contractors will be subject to approval by the City of Vernonia, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development through the Community Action Team of Columbia County and the Farmers Home Administration as to form and content of the Contract between the City of Vernonia and any successful bidder.

The City of Vernonia reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive all informalities. No bidder may withdraw or modify their bid after the hour set for the opening and thereafter until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.
