INVITATION TO BID

**FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF
NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CIRCLE CURB
CONSTRUCTION**

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on April 30, 1986, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "CONSTRUCTION OF NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CIRCLE CURB CONSTRUCTION."

The proposed work consists of: The construction of approximately 340 lineal feet of topset concrete in the form of traffic circles per attached plans. The construction of one six-inch (6") high traffic island with approximately four (4) square yards of concrete and the installation of two-inch (2") galvanized steel pipe in the island, and performance of such additional incidental work as is called for by the plans and specifications.

The exact coordination of curb installation, excavation, and landscaping will be discussed and scheduled during the preconstruction meeting.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC CIRCLE CURB CONSTRUCTION," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before April 20, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

Inquiries concerning the contents of the bid specifications should be directed to Mr. John Morgan, Senior Planner.

The project is to be assisted, in whole or in part, with Federal Funds made available under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974. The provisions of Executive Order 11246, as amended, require the cooperation of bidders, contractors, sub-contractors and proposed sub-contractors in the administration of the compliance with equal employment opportunity and affirmative action requirements. Prospective bidders may direct inquiries concerning these requirements to the office mentioned above where plans and bids are obtained. In addition, attendance at prebid, preaward and/or preconstruction conference may be required to discuss specific requirements and programs for compliance.
