



ELECTRICAL APPRENTICESHIP APPLICATIONS

The Metro Electrical Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee will accept applications during a two week period starting Thursday, May 1, 1986 and continuing through Wednesday, May 14, 1986. Applications must be filled out **in person** at the Metro Office — 5600 N.E. 42nd Avenue, Portland, (N.E. 42nd and Killingsworth).

Applicants must have official high school transcripts (send directly from the high school to Metro Training) and aptitude test results received in this office by the close of business, 5 p.m., Friday, May 30, 1986 to be completed on time.

Applicants will be scheduled for an aptitude test at the time they fill out applications.

Interviews for those who complete their applications on time will be held in June. Each successful applicant will be notified **by mail** of his or her interview time and final standing. Others will also be notified **by mail**.



Minimum qualifications for the program are:

1. 18 years of age.
2. High school graduate with a 2.0 G.P.A. (C average) or G.E.D. of 255 (official high school transcript must be furnished in either case).
3. High score on aptitude test.
4. Passing grade for first year algebra (or two college quarters of algebra).
5. Resident of this committee's area.
