Red Cross Baby Care Course Offered

The American Red Cross is offering a Baby Care class in three parts on Saturdays, May 3, 10 and 17, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at the Red Cross Headquarters, 3131 N. Vancouver Avenue.

This course is for expectant, new, and adopting parents and grandparents to prepare them to understand and fulfill the special needs of infants through their first year of life. Taught by authorized Red Cross volunteer instructors, the subjects covered will include feeding, handling and bathing, characteristics of the infant, family adjustments, growth and development during the first year, and safety and health care for infants.

Pre-registration is necessary since class size is limited. A charge of \$15 per couple or individual will be made to cover the cost of materials. Scholarships for Baby Care and other Red Cross courses are available. Call Red Cross at 284-1234, ext. 175, for information and registration.

The wake was held Monday and the funeral was Tuesday April 22, 1986 and during it "All" testimonies of love and admiration "went-up" to the glory and honor of God concerning the life of our dearly beloved sister in the Lord, Missionary Jessie M. Daniels who departed this earth April 16, 1986.

Jackson, all of Portland; three sisters, Bufor Harris of Portland and Ronal Pierce and Florence Stewart, both of Los Angeles; 13 grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren.

Indian Health Centers

Receive Mark of Excellence

Don J. Davis, Director of the Portland Area Indian Health Service announced today that all of the agency's eleven comprehensive ambulatory health care centers have achieved full accreditation by the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Hospitals (J.C.A.H.). This is the first Indian Health Service Area in the Nation to receive this distinction.

The Indian Health Service, a component of the U.S. Public Health Service, within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, provides health care services to Indian people under long established treaties with Indian tribes. The Portland Area serves approximately 60,000 Indians in thirty-seven tribes throughout the states of Idaho, Oregon, and Washington.

The J.C.A.H. is an independent private non-profit nationally recognized organization, noted for assuring that the highest standards of quality are maintained in health care facilities. Accreditation by J.C.A.H. is regarded as a mark of excellence throughout the health care system.

In making the announcement, Davis stated that, "We are particularly pleased to receive the J.C.A.H. accreditation because our clients will know that they are receiving the best quality care available in our Indian clinics."

In another first for the Portland Area Indian Health Service, Davis announced that all of its offices and health facilities throughout Idaho, Oregon, and Washington, have achieved smoke-free status. "We have a responsibility to our patients and our staff to provide a healthy environment," Davis said. "This is another step toward the Surgeon General's goal of a smoke-free society by the year 2000."
