

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, Room B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until 2:00 p.m., PDT, Thursday, May 22, 1986, for the Apperson Hall and Merryfield Hall Alterations project located at Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building "A", Room A622-D by the Undersigned or a designated representative.

The project includes demolition, concrete, carpentry, doors, cabinets, ceilings, painting and associated mechanical and electrical work.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained from the office of Jeppsen, Miller and Tobias, Architects, 245 NE Conifer Blvd., Corvallis, Oregon 97330 (754-7541) by prime bidders only upon deposit of \$25. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction. Subcontractors and others may purchase a set of plans and specifications for \$15.

Pre-qualification of bidders is not required.

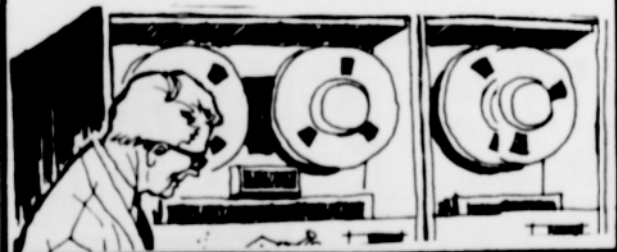

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Sealed bids for the University of Oregon Science II No. 38 Energy Conservation Measures, USDOC/ICP, will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Conference Room 2, UO Physical Plant Department, 1295 Franklin Boulevard, Eugene, Oregon 97403-1276, until 2:30 p.m., PDT, Thursday, May 29, 1986, and then publicly opened and read aloud by the Undersigned or his designated representative.

Briefly, the work includes ECM No. 5, installation of a run-around heat recovery system including preheat coils, piping, and other equipment for SF-3 and 4.

Bids will be received on a lump sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained by prime bidders only from the University of Oregon Physical Plant Department upon deposit of \$50.00. Contract documents may be obtained by other than prime bidders for the cost of reproduction plus a deposit of \$50.00.
