**INVITATION TO BID
FOR THE SANITARY SEWER
REHABILITATION IN THE ALLEY
WEST OF FIR STREET SOUTH,
SUPERIOR STREET TO LINCOLN STREET**

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on May 21, 1986, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "THE SANITARY SEWER REHABILITATION IN THE ALLEY WEST OF FIR STREET SOUTH, SUPERIOR STREET TO LINCOLN STREET"

The proposed work consists of: 710 lineal feet of 8-inch pipe, 15 service reconnections, and appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON ALLEY WEST OF FIR STREET SOUTH," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before May 13, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the University of Oregon Library No. 18 Energy Conservation Measures (ECM's), BPA/IBP, will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Conference Room 2, UO Physical Plant Department, 1295 Franklin Boulevard, Eugene, Oregon 97402-1276, until 2:30 p.m., Thursday, June 6, 1986, and then publicly opened and read aloud by the Under-signed or a designated representative.

Briefly, the work includes:

ECM No. 5, retrofitting existing with new lenses and removing lamps and ballasts as specified.

Bids will be received on a lump sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained by prime bidders only from the University of Oregon Physical Plant Department upon deposit of \$50.00. Contract documents may be obtained by other than prime bidders for the cost of reproduction plus a deposit of \$50.00.

Deposits will be refunded for documents returned in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, but to non-bidders only if returned no later than one week prior to bid opening.

Contract documents may be examined at the UO Physical Plant Department; Builders Exchange Cooperative, and Construction Data Plan Center, Portland; Dodge/SCAN, Seattle, Washington; Douglas County Builders Exchange, Roseburg; Eugene Builders Exchange, Eugene; Medford Builders Exchange, Medford; Northwest Plan Center, Portland; Oregon Builders Exchange, Roseburg; and Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 3:00 p.m. PDT in the Physical Plant Conference Room, Eugene, Oregon 97403, on Friday, May 23, 1986.

Prequalifications of bidders is not required.

All bidders must comply with the requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279.350.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.
