Sealed bids for the Terminal 4, Toyota Processing Yard Expansion will be received by the Purchasing Manager of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon, (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until 2 p.m., May 29, 1986, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) Good-Faith-Effort Program:

Bidders are required to show that subcontractors, suppliers, and manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) or the City of Portland as Minority Business Enterprises or Women Business Enterprises will participate in not less than the following percentages of the total dollar amount bid:

Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs) 10 Percent
Women Business Enterprises (WBEs) 3 Percent

Scope:

Demolition and removal of concrete foundations and floors, grade and pave an approximate 8.5 acre auto processing site including installation of site drainage, installation of new chain-link fence and gates, and construction of concrete curb and sidewalk and site landscaping.

A prebid conference will be held on Monday, May 19, 1986, at 10 a.m. in the Terminal 4 Administration Building to discuss all phases of the work.

Bids must be on the bid form which will be provided to prospective bidders and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to The Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

Bidders are required to prequalify. Prequalification statements must be received at least 5 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 5 days before bid opening, but consideration by Port cannot be assured.

The drawings and the contract manual may be examined at Port offices. Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders at no cost.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.
