SEWER IMPROVEMENTS  
ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS**

Sealed bids for the construction of SEWER IMPROVEMENTS in the City of Rainier, Oregon addressed to the Mayor and City Council, 106 B West, P.O. Box A, Rainier, Oregon 97048, will be received until 3:00 p.m. local time on the 12th day of June, 1986 in the City Recorder's Office in City Hall at the above address at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists of constructing approximately 5260 lineal feet of 8, 12, 15, 18 and 21 inch diameter storm drains; 24 manholes and 27 catch inlets. All work is located within the improved roadway.

The Contract Documents may be examined at the Rainier City Hall; Northwest Plan Center, 901 S.E. Oak, Portland, Oregon; at Builders Exchange, 1125 S.E. Bidders upon returning the Documents, in good condition, within 10 days of the bid opening will be refunded their payment; non-bidders upon so returning the Documents will be refunded \$35.00.

Bidders in doubt as to their qualifications to perform the work are encouraged to contact the Engineer informally to determine if a prequalification request is necessary. Prequalification requests must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on the 30th day of May, 1986.

Each Bid must contain a statement by the Bidder that the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be complied with.

Prospective Bidders are advised that the work is partially funded by a grant from the State of Oregon Inter-governmental Relations Division and that the work will be subject to the prevailing wage rates established by the U.S. Department of Labor and to Equal Employment Opportunity requirements.

Each proposal must be submitted on the prescribed form and accompanied by a certified check or bid bond payable to the City of Rainier, Oregon in an amount of not less than 10 percent of the total amount of the Bid.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds in the full amount of the contract price.

The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informalities in bidding. No Bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 30 calendar days after the opening thereof.

Sealed bids for Amazon Family Housing Roof and Foundation Renovation. University of Oregon, Eugene, Oregon will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education at University of Oregon, Physical Plant Department, Conference Room 2, 1295 Franklin Boulevard, Eugene, Oregon 97403, until 2:00 p.m., PDT, June 10, 1986, and then publicly opened and read aloud by the Undersigned or a designated representative.

Briefly the work is described as the reconstruction of 12 building roofs, including selective demolition and the construction of a new foundation under one building at Amazon Family Housing Complex, Eugene, Oregon.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained by prime bidders only, from U of O Physical Plant Department, upon deposit of \$50.00. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction.

Deposits will be refunded for documents returned in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening bids, but to non-bidders only if returned no later than one week prior to bid opening.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by bid security.
