INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, until, but not after 11:00 a.m., June 18, 1986, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

Prime contractors interested in bidding on this project may receive one copy of the specifications and other bid documents at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302. The proposed work consists of the preparation and painting of building exteriors at various locations within the City of Salem.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to prequalified bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON PAINTING OF BUILDINGS/HOUSING AUTHORITY", and show the name and business address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidder will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been awarded.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem or any of its officers unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder that the provisions of the Davis-Bacon Act, 40 USCA 276a(a) shall be included in his contract.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities and of postponing the award of the contract for thirty (30) days.

No bid will be received from any bidder who has not filed a prequalification statement with the City Purchasing Supervisor. Statements must be received by 5:00 p.m. on or before June 10, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes. **PREQUALIFICATION CLASS: PAINTING & DECORATING.**

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

NOTE: This project is federally funded through the Department of Housing and Urban Development and all requirements of that agency pertaining to bidding and contract performance shall be strictly adhered to.

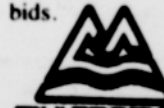
NONDISCRIMINATION

No proposal will be considered unless accompanied by a check payable to Multnomah County, certified by a responsible bank, or in lieu thereof, a surety bond for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the aggregate proposal. The successful bidder shall furnish a bond satisfactory to the Board in the full amount of the contract.

Multnomah County reserves the right to reject any or all bids.
