GASOLINE PRICE DECLINE

Gasoline prices showed a continued decline in Oregon, according to the Oregon AAA Memorial Day Fuel Gauge Survey.

Prices dropped an average of six cents per gallon since the Easter survey was conducted in March.

For the Memorial Day weekend, full-service cash customers will pay an average of 95 cents per gallon for regular, \$1.04 for unleaded and \$1.18 for super unleaded.

Customers at mini-serve pumps will pay an average of 86 cents per gallon for regular, 94 cents for unleaded and \$1.08 for super unleaded.

Credit card customers will pay an average of five cents per gallon more.

Almost 90 percent of the service stations surveyed on major Oregon travel routes will remain open through the Memorial Day holiday.
