Sealed bids for the Portland International Airport, Taxiway B Extension, will be received by the Purchasing Manager of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon, (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until 2 p.m. July 1, 1986, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) Good-Faith-Effort Program:

Bidders are required to show that subcontractors, suppliers, and manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) or the City of Portland as Minority Business Enterprises or Women Business Enterprises will participate in not less than the following percentages of the total dollar amount bid:

Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs): ...10 Percent
Women Business Enterprises (WBEs): ...3 Percent

Scope:

Construction of an asphalt concrete taxiway approximately 75 feet by 1,500 feet including earthwork, drainage, paving, marking, and lighting; extension of an aircraft parking apron and asphalt overlay of an existing taxiway including earthwork, drainage, cold planing, paving, marking, and lighting; encasing existing electrical ducts; removing existing lighting and installing new lighting in base cans with connecting ducts; installing new duct banks and pull boxes; installing new airfield guidance signs.

A prebid conference will be held on Tuesday, June 17, 1986, at 10:30 a.m. in Conference Room 3002 on the third floor mezzanine in the Terminal Building at Portland International Airport to discuss all phases of the work.

Bids must be on the bid form which will be provided to prospective bidders and must be accompanied by a certified or

cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to The Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

Bidders are required to prequalify. Prequalification statements must be received at least 5 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 5 days before bid opening, but consideration by Port cannot be assured.

The drawings and the contract manual may be examined at Port offices. Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders upon deposit of \$20, which deposit will be refunded upon return of the drawings, contract manual, and other documents in good condition within 2 weeks after bid opening.

This is a federal aid contract, and all labor shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates established by the U. S. Secretary of Labor, as included in the contract documents.

The labor and equal employment opportunity requirements referenced in the Bid will apply to this work. The proposed Contract is under the subject of Executive Order 11246 on Nondiscrimination Under Federal Contracts, September 24, 1965, and as amended; and 49 CFR Part 23, on Participation of Minority Business Enterprise in Department of Transportation Programs, March 31, 1980.

Minority business enterprises and women business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award of any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement.
