Sealed bids for the Portland International Airport, Southwest/South Central Perimeter Road, will be received by the Purchasing Manager of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon, (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon 97208) until 3 p.m. June 24, 1986, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) Good Faith Effort Program:

Bidders are required to show that subcontractors, suppliers, and manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) or the City of Portland as Minority Business Enterprises or Women Business Enterprises will participate in not less than the following percentages of the total dollar amount bid:

**Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs): ... 10 Percent**  
**Women Business Enterprises (WBEs): ... 3 Percent**

**Scope:**

Construct approximately 1.33 miles of 20-foot-wide road; re-grade area between new road and Taxiway E; stripe and mark new road; and extend existing 8-inch, 12-inch, and 30-inch CMP and 15-inch CSP culverts.

A prebid conference will be held on Monday, June 16, 1986, at 9 a.m. in Conference Room 3002 on the third floor mezzanine in the Terminal Building at Portland International Airport to discuss all phases of the work.

Bids must be on the bid form which will be provided to prospective bidders and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to

The Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

Bidders are required to prequalify. Prequalification statements must be received at least 5 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 5 days before bid opening, but consideration by Port cannot be assured.

The drawings and the contract manual may be examined at Port offices. Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders at no cost.

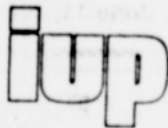
This is a federal aid contract, and all labor shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates established by the U.S. Secretary of Labor, as included in the contract documents.
