

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the University of Oregon Computer Center New Chilled Water Supply will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Conference Room 2, UO Physical Plant Department, 1295 Franklin Boulevard, Eugene, Oregon 97403-1276 until 3:00 p.m., PDT, Wednesday July 9, 1986, and then publicly opened and read aloud by the Undersigned or his designated representative.

Briefly, the work is described as the installation of approximately 250 feet of pre-fabricated underground utility tunnel and 500 feet of 3" chilled water supply and return piping. The work will connect the existing tunnel and chilled water piping from the Law Center to the areaway at the Computer Center.

Bids will be received on a lump sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained by prime bidders only from the University of Oregon Physical Plant Department upon deposit of \$50.00. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction, plus a deposit of \$50.00.

Deposits will be refunded for documents returned in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, but to non-bidders only if returned no later than one week prior to bid opening.

Contract documents may be examined at the UO Physical Plant Department; Balzhiser/Hubbard & Associates; Builders Exchange Cooperative, and Construction Data Plan Center, Portland; Dodge/SCAN, Seattle, Washington; Douglas County Builders Exchange, Roseburg; Eugene Builders Exchange, Eugene; Northwest Plan Center, Portland; and Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem.

A Pre-Bid Conference will be held at 3:30 p.m., PDT, Thursday, June 26, 1986, in the Physical Plant Conference Room, Eugene, Oregon 97403.

Prequalification of bidders is not required for this project.

All bidders must comply with the requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279.350.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instructions to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.

INVITATION TO BID

The City of Salem will receive sealed bids at the office of the City Recorder, Room 205, City Hall, Salem, Oregon 97301, until, but not after 11:00 a.m., July 2, 1986, at which time said bids will be publicly opened and read in the City Council Chambers, Room 240, City Hall, for the project specified herein.

Prime contractors interested in bidding on this project may receive one copy of the specifications and other bid documents at the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97392. The proposed work consists of all necessary equipment, labor, and materials according to the plans and specifications for the construction and installation of softball field lighting at Wallace Marine Park, Salem, Oregon.

Bids must be submitted on the proposal forms furnished to prequalified bidders. Proposals shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON SOFTBALL FIELD LIGHTING AT WALLACE MARINE PARK", and show the name and business address of the bidder.

Any objections to or comments upon these specifications must be submitted in writing to the office of the Purchasing Supervisor, 1340 20th St. S.E., Salem, Oregon 97302 not later than five (5) days prior to the bid opening.

No bid will be received from any bidder who has not filed a prequalification statement with the City Purchasing Supervisor. Statements must be received by 5:00 p.m. on or before June 25, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

PREQUALIFICATION CLASS: ILLUMINATION AND/OR ELECTRICAL WIRING.

A surety bond, cashier's check, or certified check of the bidder in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must be attached to each proposal as bid security. Unsuccessful bidders will have their security refunded to them when the contract has been awarded.

The City of Salem reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive formalities and of postponing the award of the contract for thirty (30) days.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.

NOTE: A MANDATORY site orientation will be held at the Wallace Marine Park Sports Fields at 200 Glen Creek Road N.W., Salem, Oregon at 10:00 a.m., June 23, 1986. Only one orientation will be held. All prospective bidders MUST attend. Attendance at the entire orientation, which is expected to last approximately two (2) hours is required.

This project is to be assisted, in whole or in part, with federal funds made available from the National Park Service, Land and Water Conservation Fund. The provisions of Executive Order 11246, as amended, require the cooperation of bidders, contractors, sub-contractors and proposed sub-contractors in the administration of the compliance with equal employment opportunity and affirmative action requirements. In addition, attendance at a pre-construction conference may be required to discuss specific requirements and programs for compliance.
