TO A POINT 250 FEET SOUTHERLY**

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on July 23, 1986, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND RECONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, SIDEWALKS, AND PAVEMENT ON 24TH STREET NORTHEAST AND CENTER STREET TO A POINT 250 FEET SOUTHERLY."

The proposed work consists of: the installation of a new five (5) phase traffic signal, removal and replacement of the existing east and west curblines and radii, construction of new sidewalks, installation of new storm drainage, catch basins and cleanout, pavement widening and other such incidental work as called for by the plans and specifications, and appurtenant work.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty Street S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AND RECONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, SIDEWALKS, AND PAVEMENT ON 24TH STREET NORTHEAST AND CENTER STREET TO A POINT 250 FEET SOUTHERLY," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned

following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

Contractor's Prequalification Applications must be submitted to the City Purchasing Supervisor (1340 20th Street S.E., Salem, OR 97302) for approval, on or before July 15, 1986, which is at least five working days prior to the scheduled bid opening date. Upon approval the bidder will receive a valid proposal for bidding purposes.

No bid shall be received or considered from any bidder who does not have an approved prequalification application on file with the City Purchasing Supervisor.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.
