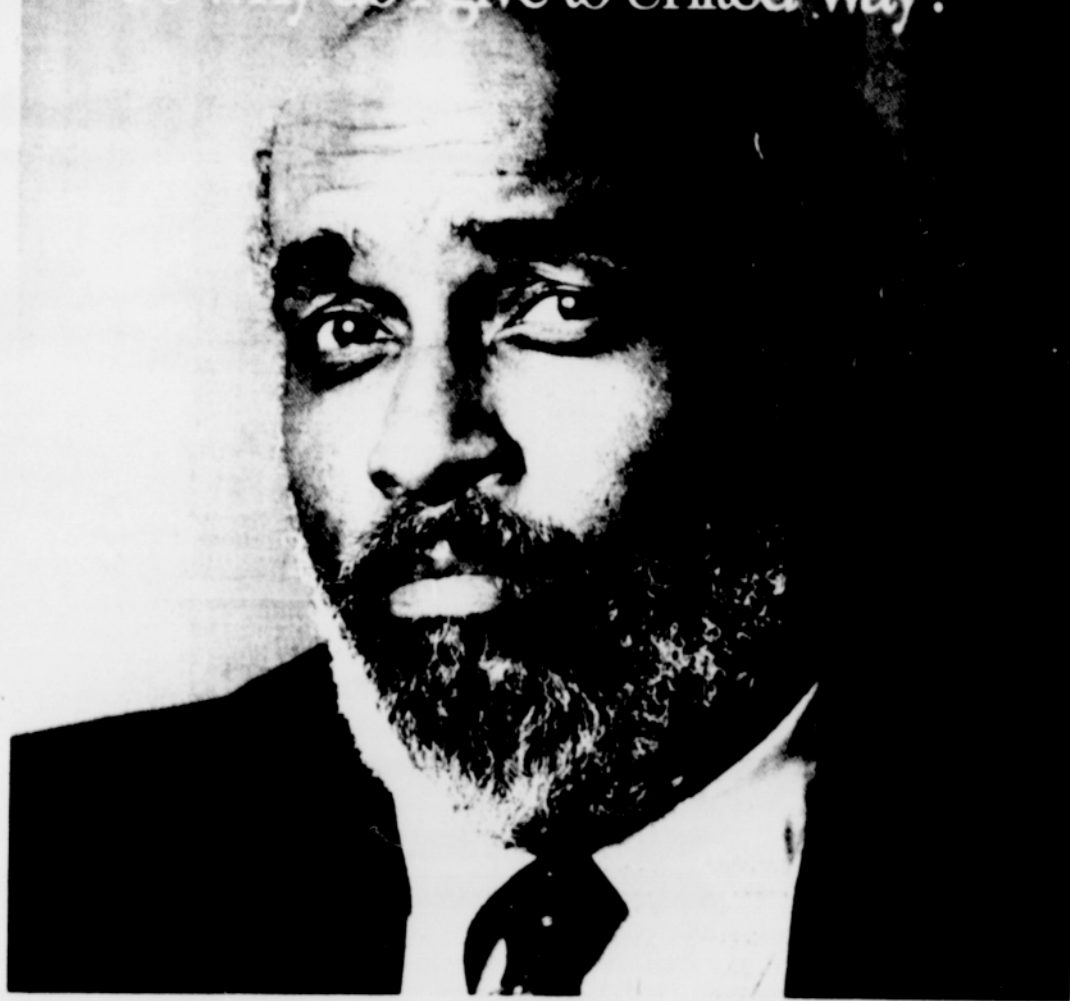


"I don't believe in special

So why do I give to United Way?"



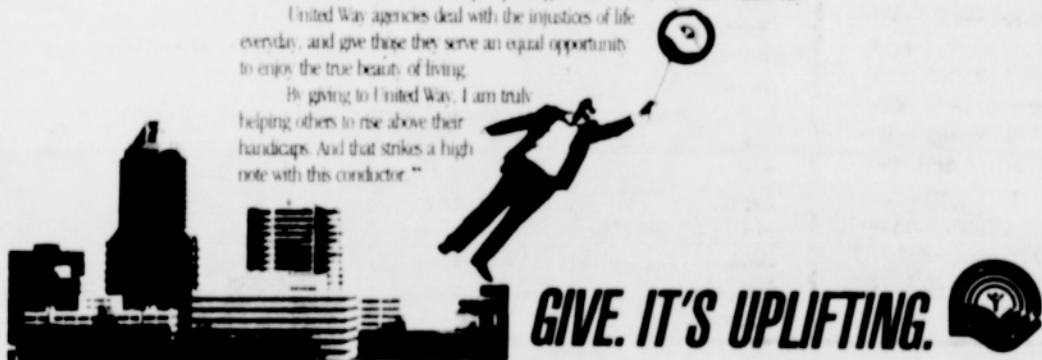
"Life doesn't come with any guarantees. I know that as well as anyone. I became a victim of polio at the age of 26.
