INVITATION TO BID

FOR THE MISSION STREET SEWAGE PUMP STATION REHABILITATION AND FORCE MAIN

Sealed bids will be received at the office of the City Recorder, City hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon, until but not after 11:00 a.m., Local Time on **August 20, 1986**, at which time all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Council Chambers, Civic Center, 555 Liberty St S.E., Salem, Oregon for the "MISSION STREET SEWAGE PUMP STATION REHABILITATION AND FORCE MAIN".

The proposed work consists of: Sewage Pump Station Improvements to the existing Mission Street Pump Station and Force Main/Gravity Main Improvements to the existing Gravity Main along Mission Street; consisting of two schedules with the following approximate quantities, and appurtenant work.

SCHEDULE A

1. 27-inch Sewerline Construction . . 446 Lineal Feet
2. 18-inch Sewerline Construction . . 348 Lineal Feet
3. Rehabilitate, using the Insituform method, 18-inch Sewerline 867 Lineal Feet
4. Installation of miscellaneous fittings and appurtenances

SCHEDULE B

1. Modify Existing Mission Street Sewage Pump Station and Emergency Generator facility.

Plans, specifications and other bid documents may be inspected and obtained at the office of the City of Salem, Department of Public Works, 555 Liberty St. S.E., Room 325, Salem, Oregon. The bidder shall not file the book of "Standard Construction Specifications" with his bid.

One copy may be obtained by potential bidders upon receipt of cash or check in the amount of \$10.00 made payable to the Owner. Payment made upon procurement of drawings, specifications, and forms

of contract documents will be nonrefundable. Individual sheets and specification pages may be purchased for the cost of reproduction: Drawing, \$1.00 per sheet; Specifications, \$.10 (ten cents) per sheet.

Bids shall be made on the forms furnished by the City, addressed, and mailed or delivered to the City Recorder, City Hall, Room 205, Salem, Oregon 97301, in a sealed envelope plainly marked "BID ON MISSION STREET SEWAGE PUMP STATION REHABILITATION AND FORCE MAIN," and the name and address of the bidder.

A surety bond, cashier's check or certified check of the bidder, made payable to the City of Salem, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the bid must accompany each bid as security. Bid security of all save the three lowest bidders will be returned following the bid opening; all bid security will be refunded upon execution of the contract by the successful bidder.

No bid will be received or considered by the City of Salem unless the bid contains a statement by the bidder the provisions of ORS 279.350 shall be included in his contract.

The attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Chapter 97, Salem Revised Code, concerning unlawful employment practices. Violation of such provisions shall be grounds for immediate termination of this contract without recourse by the contractor.
