Reagan's speech wasn't surprising. "The speech was an insult to the intelligence of the American people."

Gordly went on to say that the President's policy of "constructive engagement" hasn't accomplished any meaningful changes in that country. "It is time for the Administration to enact sanctions against the Pretoria government. The American people want sanctions."

Gordly said Blacks in South Africa are willing to suffer the consequences of sanctions. "While in St.

Louis last week, I spoke with the Deputy Ambassador in Zimbabwe. He said the frontline states in South Africa are willing to suffer the hardships as the result of sanctions."

Gordly urges Oregonians to write both Senators Bob Packwood and Mark Hatfield to support Senate Bill 2570. SB 2570, if passed by the Senate, will place a ban on new U.S. investment in South Africa; a ban on U.S. bank loans to the South African private sector; and a ban on the importation of certain minerals from South Africa.
