

## CALL FOR BIDS

### FOR SHUTE PARK LIGHTING SYSTEM

A portion of this project is financed through the Community Development Block Grant Program with funds obtained from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. The entire contract will be subject to regulations of the Departments of Labor and Housing and Urban Development.

Attention is called to Federal provisions for Equal Employment Opportunity, Affirmative Action, H.U.D. Section 3 requirements and the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the contract documents.

Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the City Manager, First Floor, City Hall, Hillsboro, Oregon until: 11:00 a.m., August 29, 1986, at which time bids will be opened and read publicly.

The general nature and approximate quantities of work are as follows:

Modification to an existing electrical service, underground wiring and the installation of 27 light poles with fixtures.

Documents will not be mailed unless advance money for postage is received (\$3.00). There is a \$5.00 nonrefundable deposit on each bid book.

No bids will be considered unless the bidder states that provisions required by the Federal Fair Labor Standards Provision relating to prevailing Davis-Bacon wage rates shall be complied with.

## INVITATION FOR BID

### SPRINKLER SYSTEM

Sealed bids are requested for all labor and materials required for the installation of an automatic fire sprinkling system and will be received at 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon, 97203 until 2:00 p.m. PDT Tuesday, September 2, 1986. Shortly thereafter, bids will be opened and publicly read and the attendance of bidders is welcome.

Basically the work consists of installing an underground fireline to a warehouse/shop building located at the above address and constructing an automatic fire sprinkler within the building.

Interested bidders may obtain one set of bid documents at the HAP Maintenance Office located at 8910 N. Woolsey Avenue, Portland, Oregon, 97203 upon receipt of deposit of \$20 which is refundable. Documents must be returned to HAP in good condition within 10 days after bid opening in order to receive refund of deposit. Additional sets may be acquired for \$10 which is not refundable.

A HAP representative will conduct a tour of the job site commencing at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 20, 1986 and the attendance of all bidders is requested. Questions posed at that time regarding the project that are not addressed in the specifications will be answered by addenda and provided to all bidders by mail.

No bid will be considered unless accompanied by bid security in the form of certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond payable to the Housing Authority of Portland in an amount equal to 10% of the bid which is to be forfeited as fixed and liquidated damages should bidder neglect or refuse to enter into a contract or provide a suitable bond for the faithful performance of the work when bidder is notified of contract award.

A minimum of 20% MBE participation in the execution of this project is a HAP requirement and the methods the bidder proposes to comply with this requirement is subject to HAP review and approval prior to initiating the contract.

No bidder may withdraw bid after the hour set for opening thereof until after the lapse of sixty (60) days from the bid opening.

The Housing Authority of Portland may reject any bid not in compliance with the prescribed bidding procedures and requirements and may reject any or all bids and waive all informalities, if in the judgment of HAP it is in the public interest to do so.
