August 25 & 26, and only August 25 & 26, the Housing Authority of Portland will be accepting applications for their Section 8 Housing Assistance Payment Program for Low-Income Renters.

HAP will be accepting telephone calls to the special phone numbers listed below **only** during the hours of 8:30 to 4:00 on August 25 & 26. (HAP will be closed from 11:30 to 1:00 on those days for Staff lunches.)

HAP will only be accepting names from families who need two (2) or three (3) bedrooms.

If you are currently on HAP's Conventional waiting list and wish to apply for this program, you will need to call, using the special numbers listed below, **during these days only**, to make a separate application.

To have your name placed on the waiting list for this program, please **DO NOT CALL OTHER HAP PHONE NUMBERS**, but call **284-2045** and **284-2140**.

WE WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTING PHONE CALLS, AND ON THESE NUMBERS ONLY. WE WILL NOT ACCEPT WALK-IN'S OR NAMES RECEIVED THROUGH THE MAIL. YOU MUST CALL IF YOU WISH TO APPLY FOR THIS PROGRAM.

Only one family's application will be accepted per phone call.

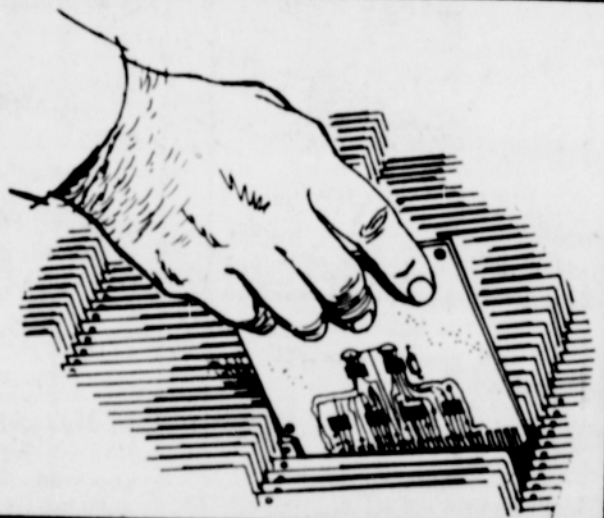


