Sealed bids for the Terminal 4, Grain Road Improvements will be received by the Purchasing Manager of The Port of Portland, 700 N.E. Multnomah Street, Portland, Oregon, (mailing address: Post Office Box 3529, Portland, Oregon, 97208) until 2 p.m., September 3, 1986, and thereafter publicly opened and read.

Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) and Women Business Enterprise (WBE) Good-Faith-Effort Program:

Bidders are required to show that subcontractors, suppliers, and manufacturers which have been certified by the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) or the City of Portland as Minority Business Enterprises or Women Business Enterprises will participate in not less than the following percentages of the total dollar amount bid:

Minority Business Enterprises (MBEs): 3 Percent
Women Business Enterprises (WBEs): 1 Percent

Scope:

Improvements to 2,340 lineal feet of roadway and relocating one existing irrigation lateral and re-routing existing area lighting branch circuits.

Bids must be on the bid form which will be provided to prospective bidders and must be accompanied by a certified or cashier's check drawn on a United States bank or a bid bond payable to The Port of Portland in an amount equal to at least 10 percent of the total amount bid.

Bidders are required to prequalify. Prequalification statements must be received at least 5 days prior to the time set for bid opening. Applications for prequalification may be submitted less than 5 days before bid opening, but consideration by Port cannot be assured.

The drawings and the contract manual may be examined at Port offices. Copies may be obtained by prospective bidders at no cost.

Attention is called to the provisions of the Oregon Revised Statutes 279.350, providing that workers be paid prevailing wage rates.

Sealed bids will be received by the Oregon State Board of Higher Education in Administrative Services Building, Room B100, Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon until 2:00 P.M., PDT, Tuesday, September 16, 1986, for Physical Plant Shops Alterations located at Oregon State University, Corvallis, Oregon. Bids will be opened and publicly read aloud in the Administrative Services Building, Room A622D by the Undersigned or a designated representative.

The project includes demolition, concrete, carpentry, doors, cabinets, ceilings, painting and associated mechanical and electrical work.

Bids will be received on a lump-sum basis for all of the work. One set of contract documents may be obtained from the office of Jeppson, Miller and Tobias, Architects, 245 NE Conifer Blvd., Corvallis, Oregon 97330 (754-7541) by primer bidders only upon deposit of \$25. Additional sets may be obtained for the cost of reproduction. Subcontractors and others may purchase a set of plans and specifications for \$15.

Contract documents may be examined at the Architect's office; O.S.U. Physical Plant Office; Builders Exchange Cooperative, Portland; Eugene Builders Exchange Corporation, Eugene; Northwest Plan Center, Portland; Salem Contractors Exchange, Salem; Construction Data Plan Center, Portland; Impact Business Consultants, Portland; National Business League-Oregon Chapter, c/o CSS & Associates, Portland; and Central Oregon Builders Exchange, Bend.

Deposits will be refunded for contract documents returned in good condition by actual bidders within two weeks after opening of bids, but to nonbidders only if returned no later than the day of the bid opening.

Pre-qualification of bidders is not required.

Mandatory examination of the site and conditions will be made on Wednesday, September 3, 1986 at 1:30 P.M. Bidders shall meet with Owner and Architect at the Physical Plant Office prior to required examination.

All bidders must comply with the requirements of the prevailing wage law in ORS 279.350.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the "Instruction to Bidders" upon the Bid Form provided and accompanied by Bid Security.
