Enterostomal therapy services are now being offered to outpatients as well as inpatients by Meridian Park Hospital's Enterostomal Therapy Department. The department is open Tuesday through Friday from 7:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. and scheduling is by appointment saily.

Department services are coordinated by Pat Robbins, R.N., Enterostomal Therapist. "Patients require a physician's order to access these services," said Robbins. Services are for people with ostomies or incontinence problems including teaching and evaluations. "Many of the services provided by the department are covered by insurance providers, she added, and in many cases 80-100% of the ordinary fees are covered."
