All June Graduates of PCC Nursing Program Pass Licensing Exam

All 66 June graduates of the two-year registered nursing program at Portland Community College passed the National Council Licensure Examination, according to Shirley R. Anderson, PCC Nursing Programs chair.

It was the third consecutive year that PCC graduates recorded a 100 percent passing rate on the required examination, she said.

Passing scores for the test range from a minimum 1600 points to a maximum 3200, Anderson said. Mean average of the PCC graduates was 2201. Best of the PCC scores was 2965 points.

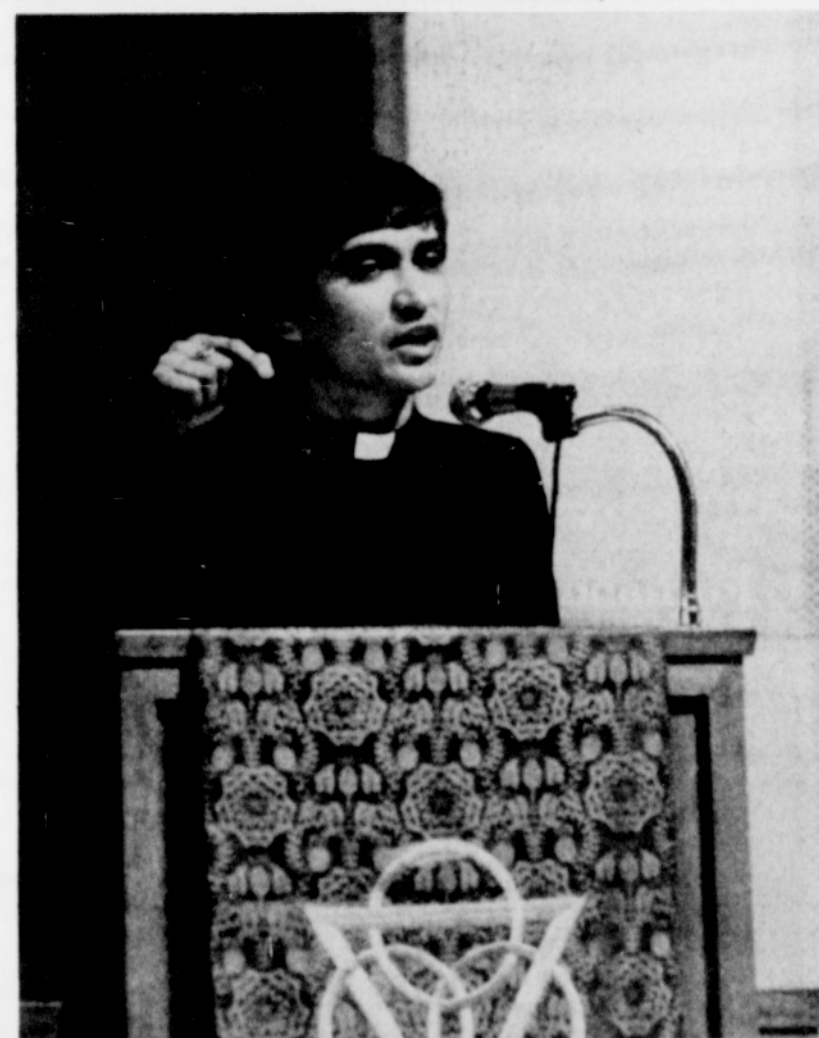
