Equipment for Disaster Victims

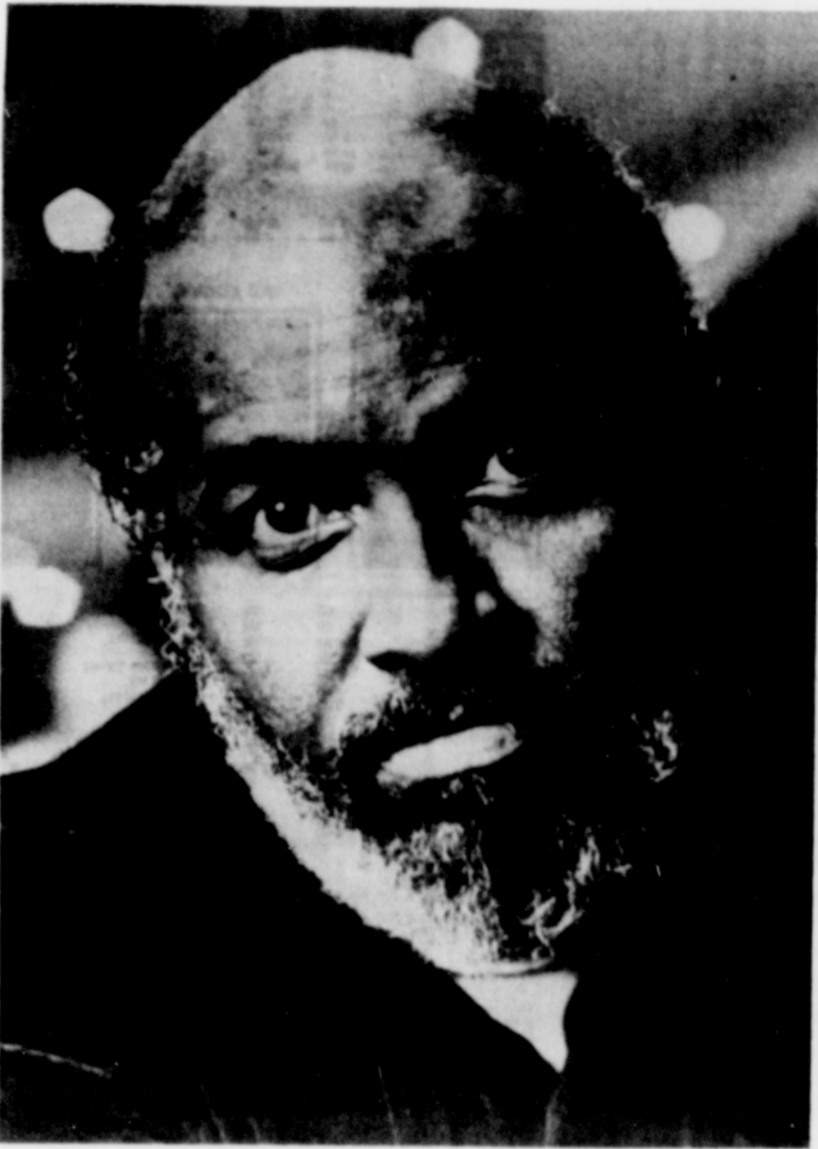
At its meeting on September 25, the East Portland Rotary Club presented a check for \$475 toward emergency medical equipment for Red Cross Disaster Services. Red Cross will use the equipment for temporary loan to disabled disaster victims in the Portland area whose own equipment is lost or damaged as the result of a fire or other disaster.

Having this equipment will enable Red Cross to respond immediately to disaster victims who would otherwise be left without mobility under these circumstances. Red Cross Disaster Relief services are provided on a 24-hour-a-day basis and basic needs of victims are attended to immediately. Replacement of medical equipment usually takes longer. The Red Cross will purchase a wheelchair, canes, crutches and walkers with the money presented by East Portland Rotary club president, Karl Koch.
